

THE 2008 INAUGURAL GALA DINNER

The Topo Foundation for Education (TF4E) held its Inaugural Gala Dinner at the Sydney Shangri-La Hotel on the 4th of April 2008. This event not only served as TF4E's Official Launch, but also helped to raise **an excess of \$70,000** for the cause.

The TF4E Program focuses on Mental Health Education to the community at large, by way of promoting Awareness, Education and De-stigmatisation of Mental Illnesses such as Bipolar Disorder and Depression. One of TF4E's main aims is: **"To promote an early Diagnosis"**. The TF4E Inaugural Gala Dinner was a wonderful event and a resounding success. Over 520 people packed the Shangri-La Hotel ballroom, providing an electric, infectious and unique atmosphere whilst helping to raise much needed funds for Mental Health Education.

Bashir AC CVO not only honoured the crowded ballroom at the Shangri-La Hotel with her presence, but also asserted: **"I've never seen this ballroom so full of people ever! This initiative enables the Police workforce by way of providing specialist training to help Officers in dealing with "situations and persons" that suffer from Mental Illness and disabilities, as opposed to true criminal activities. The MHIU has also combined forces with TF4E in regards to a "different approach" for Mental Health Interventions in the community.

*Enrique (Topo) Rodriguez cooperated with David Donohue (Coordinator) in the organisation of the **July 2007 Youth Drug Forum** held at the **Maroubra Seals Club**. There were 230 people in attendance, with a true, wide cross-section of the community representing families (kids, mums and dads), consumers, addicts, offenders, professionals, businessmen and other members of the community. Topo took part in the eight person multi-disciplinary panel that addressed the attendance. **OUTCOME: A very positive participation by all with a big message resounding throughout: "MORE OF THESE MENTAL HEALTH EDUCATION INITIATIVES ARE NEEDED"**. All members of the community are invited to take part and encouraged to take responsibility for these issues affecting their families and friends.*
